Rules and Regulations

Show Payment: **CHECK (made out to BCRC) is preferred method of payment.** CC processing is available with a 5% processing fee. A Check (made out to BCRC) / CC must be provided to the office in order to get rider #. Check-in is Friday from 4pm – 7pm & Saturday starting at 7am. Plan to check out at least 15 minutes after your last ride.

Stabling Fees (Stalls / Tack Stalls): \$40/DAY and \$120/WEEKEND available Friday to Sunday. Shavings must be purchased at the show: \$12 per bag. No horse may remain on the grounds overnight without renting a stall. Horses not stabled will be charged a \$50 grounds fee.

Schooling Fee: Non-showing horses will be charged a \$40 schooling fee in addition to any stall or grounds fee. Schooling will be available on Saturday immediately following the show that is scheduled at the DSRP arena for Friday (approximately 3 pm until 9pm) and Sunday until 30 min prior to the start of each ring.

RV Hookups will be available for \$45 per night and must be paid to Dripping Springs Ranch Park.

Dress: All riders must be properly attired and may be eliminated for improper dress. Riding helmets must be worn by ALL riders when mounted. Coats are optional. T-shirts are not acceptable. Boots and a collar shirt must be worn when competing.

Changes: The management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary or appropriate to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

Coggins: Proof of a current (within the past year) Coggins test must be available.

Ribbons / Prizes: Grand and Reserve and 6 ribbons in each class – **Grand Champion and 1st Place receive prize.** Grand and Reserve announced on Sunday when the final class in a division is complete.

Add Backs: Add back amount, for the jumper classic and hunter derby are to be distributed as follows: 22%-16%-14%-10%-8%-6%. Class must make with 5 registrations for the add backs to be distributed.

Judges Decisions are final. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or any show officials on the part of any owner, manager, trainer, coach, rider or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit all fees.

Office/medic fee is \$45 per each horse on the grounds.

Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness.

All class entry fees are \$25 except Hunter Derby's and All In One Classic.

End of Year Prize – 4 Shows Combined - Must be high point junior or amateur in over fences classes to count. A prize will be awarded to the Main arena and one to the outdoor arena.

Junior / Amateur End of Year Prize Requirements

- ❖ 1 Horse / 1 Rider Amateur Award (Points stay with Rider # / horse registered)
- ❖ In unforeseen circumstances, horse substitutions are pending approval by show management.
- ❖ If more than one horse is ridden in the show by one rider points will stay with the horse/rider combo for all 4 shows.
- ❖ Training Rides do not count towards points.

**Classes designated as “over fences” will count. Main arena - .60 and up / Outdoor arena – 18” and below.*

Quick Reference Guide for Class Tables

Table	Description	Scoring
II, 1	Time First Round (SPEED)	Fewest penalties + fastest time wins.
II, 2a	Jump-Off	All clear rounds jump off.
II, 2b	Time First Jump-Off	Clear rounds jump off immediately.
II, 2c	Power & Speed	Clean first half allows for speed in second.
II, 2d	Joker/Gambler's Choice	Optional jumps for bonus points.
III	Faults Converted	Penalties = seconds added to time.
IV	Optimum Time	Time closest to set time wins.

In order to know what type of round your class is pay attention to the last number in the class number. *Example below...*

1 – Optimum Time
2 – Time First Round

3 – Power / Speed
4 – Classic

For example: Division 8 - .80 Jumper Fences
81 - .80 Jumper, Table IV is a Optimum Time round
82 - .80 Jumper, Table II.1 is a Time First Round
83 - .80 Jumper, Table II.2c is a Power & Speed Round
84 - .80 Jumper, Table II.2a is a Jump Off Round

You will also know which height you are on based on the class number because the Division and every class will start with that number. *Example above includes this as well.*
